# **INTRODUCTION**

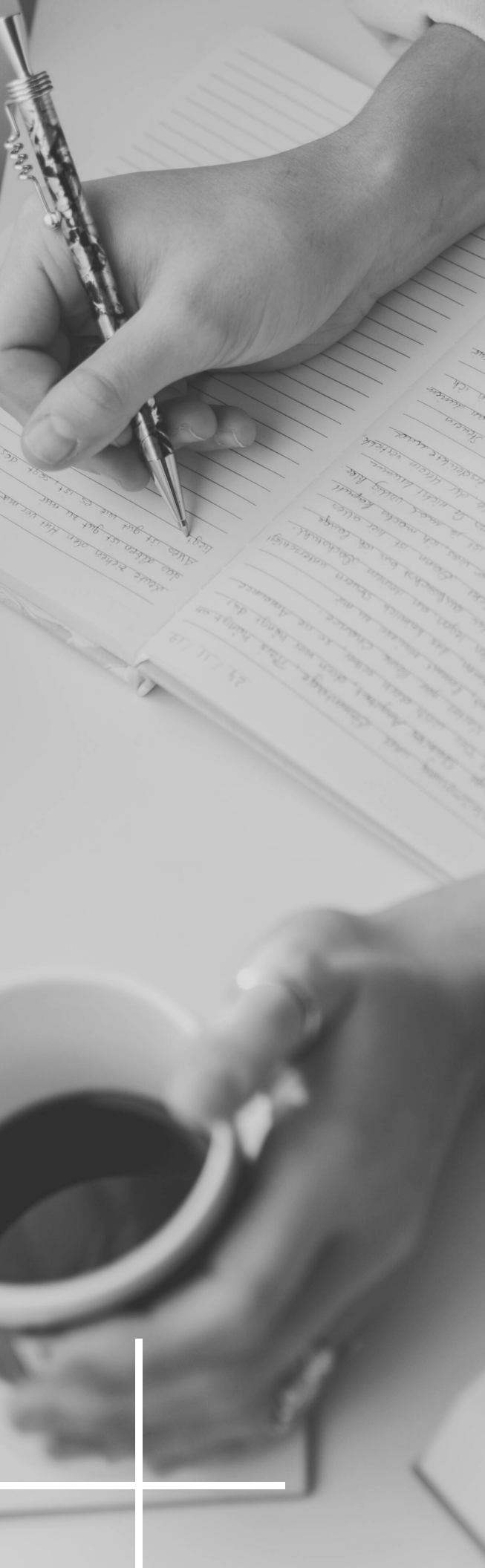
In 2021, ACLP completed a benchmark study to compare the cost of certification with other professions. Child life certification fees were compared with those from 10 similar professions to determine the average cost per year to be certified. The organizations in the study include:

- Activity Professionals
- Art Therapy
- Eating Disorder Professionals
- Family Life Educators
- Play Therapy
- Music Therapy
- Oncology Nurses
- Pediatric Nurses
- Qualified Social Workers
- Therapeutic Recreation

## **CALCULATING AN AVERAGE ANNUAL COST**

Staff compares initial certification, maintenance, and recertification fees to determine an average annual cost of certification. These figures factor in the real cost of certification through one certification cycle: initial certification, maintenance, and recertification fees.

Because the length of these certification cycles varies from two to seven years, the total cost of certification is divided by the number of years in the certification cycle to provide the average yearly cost of certification over the life of the certification cycle. Due to the variance in cycle length, this is a better figure for comparison than the total cost of certification.

For ACLP Members, the annual cost is \$128, \$23 less than that of the other organizations.

For non-members, the annual cost is \$190, \$10 less than that of the other organizations.

# **RECOMMENDATIONS**

Based on the results of the benchmarking study, staff has recommended keeping fees steady at this time with a slight increase to the maintenance and recertification fees over the course of the next few years.

A maintenance fee increase of \$2 and a recertification fee increase of \$5 is proposed for 2024. With these modest increases and assuming the other professions make no changes to their fees, ACLP’s fees will continue to be lower than the average as is noted below.
